The tables shows the calculations for the FPG for optional use in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023 LIHEAP and mandatory use in FFY 2024 LIHEAP. The amount of the household's LIHEAP award is determined by the household's FPL and fuel type.							
(2)	Households are income-eligible for LIHEAP when the household's gross income is equal to or less than 60% State Median Income (SMI) for their household size. This is for mandatory use starting from October 1, 2023. Guidelines may be restricted based on available funding.
